

Concord Hills Recreation Club - Rules & Regulations 2017

Introduction

The Board of Directors of the Concord Hills Homeowner's Association (CHHA) and its Recreation Committee hope that the following information will help you and your family enjoy our recreational facilities to the fullest.

The recreation area is owned by the CHHA. It is operated by the Recreation Committee, a committee of volunteers reporting to the CHHA Board of Directors. Members of the Recreation Committee and the elected Board of Directors are posted on the Concord Hills website.

Use of the fenced areas (swimming pools, pool pavilion and tennis courts) is only for families who have paid the appropriate amenity fees as posted on the website. Please note the following regarding access:

1. External members—The CHHA allows a limited number of external, non-resident families to pay the amenity fees and use the facilities.
2. Swim Team—The Concord Hills Piranhas have a special and valued place in our neighborhood. They use our main swimming pool and their practice and swim meet times/dates are posted at the pool facility and on the website. The minimal impact on CHRC member access is as follows:
 - a. Morning swim practice—From 9 AM- Noon, the Piranhas have exclusive use of all swim lanes in the main pool. The small end of the pool with no lanes and the rest of the facility are still open to members for use. From 12-12:30 pm, only the two far left lanes will be used by the Swim Team with the remainder of the pool available for members.
 - b. Afternoon swim practice—Same as morning practice except that if a pool member wants to swim laps, lane 6 (far left) will be made available to the member.
 - c. Swim meets—There are generally four swim meets per season. The Piranhas have exclusive use of the fenced pool areas during the scheduled times.
 - d. Learn to swim—The Piranhas run a learn to swim program for 4 & 5 year olds for eight weeks in the summer. Sign ups will be announced.
 - e. Scheduled events—The Piranhas may reserve certain spaces for a few social or other activities, which will be posted on the calendar.
3. Special events—The CHHA may schedule and post special events or maintenance at the recreation areas which may impact member access.
4. Private functions—Part of the pool pavilion (not any portion of the pool) may be reserved by members for a private function (e.g., pool party/ birthday party). The rest of the facility is always open to all members.

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5. Playground facilities— All Concord Hills residents and all CHRC members are welcome to use the playgrounds and volleyball court at the recreation area.
 6. Access year—Paid access runs from the later of March 1 or when dues are paid through February 28- 29th of the following year. Access to the pool area is restricted to the pool season.

Our Recreation Facilities are operated by part time volunteers made up of your Concord Hills neighbors. Members using our facilities control the experience and enjoyment for fellow members. Please do your part by cleaning up after yourself (fresh food spills, left items) returning the pool furniture to the proper location and manner it was found and helping to enforce safety rules with all present.

Each member has a right to expect a neat and clean recreation area and an enjoyable experience. We can ensure that if we each do our part to make that happen. Please report any issues to the Recreation Committee at rec@concordhillsfarragut.com.

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Rules and Regulations

The rules and regulations that govern the operation of the facilities are specified below. Members must fully comply with them and must instruct their children and guests to observe them. Members and guests must follow all instructions from the pool manager. All members, the pool manager and the Recreation Committee have the responsibility to enforce the rules for the safety and enjoyment of all. The current rules and regulations are posted on the website and at the pool facility and are subject to change.

The Recreation Committee has the authority to revoke facility privileges either temporarily or for the season, as deemed appropriate, for any violations of these rules and regulations. No refund of dues will occur for any such revocation of privileges.

Suggestions or complaints may be made to the pool manager or online at rec@concordhillsfarragut.com.

The authority of the Recreation Committee or Board of Directors on any matters pertaining to the recreation areas is absolute.

Pool Use

1. **There will be no lifeguard on duty. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.**
2. The pool will be open on a full-time basis in late May and will close in September. Pool hours will be posted at the facility or on the Concord Hills website.
3. The pool manager is in charge of the pool and its adjoining facilities and reports to CHHA's Recreation Committee.
4. No smoking, chewing gum, tobacco products or illegal drugs are allowed in the pool area or under the pool pavilion (TN State Law).
5. Any accidents, no matter how minor, shall be reported to the Pool Manager or by email to rec@concordhillsfarragut.com.

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6. Use of the parking lot after hours or during open swim meets is prohibited.
7. The use of skateboards and roller blades are **not** allowed inside the fenced Recreation Club facilities.
8. No pets or other animals are allowed in the pool area.
9. Persons entering the facilities are to use their key fobs. Do not give your key fob or your personal security code to anyone who is not part of your paying household. Doing so is subject to loss of membership. Replacement or additional key fobs are available for a small charge.
10. For the sake of everyone's safety, using any item to hold open the secured entry gate open is forbidden under any circumstances.
11. Diving, use of Swim Team platforms or hanging on the lane markers is prohibited.
12. A lap lane is provided for lap swimming. Please be considerate of people swimming in the lap lanes and do not interfere with their exercise.
13. With respect to the wading pool, parents or a responsible person 11 years or older must remain with a child in the wading pool at all times. Children who are not toilet trained must be appropriately attired in swim diapers to prevent accidents & pool contamination.
14. All children, 11 years and under, must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
15. Showers should be taken before coming to the pool. Bathing suits are considered suitable swimming attire. No grubbies, cut-offs, or gym shorts are allowed in the water.
16. Admission to the pool will be refused to anyone with communicable diseases, open sores, infections, or actively bleeding wounds.
17. Running, pushing, wrestling or undue disturbances in or about the pool will not be permitted.
18. No sitting, standing, or playing on the lane markers.
19. Glass items are not permitted within the gated pool area.
20. Food & beverages are not permitted within 6 feet of pool.

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21. It is every member's responsibility to properly dispose of all litter in the proper receptacles provided to keep our pool area free of debris.
22. Entrance into the pool area after hours or during periods of shutdown, without authority, is strictly forbidden and can result in the loss of membership privileges.

Tennis Court Use

1. The tennis courts are available for the exclusive use of CHHA Recreation Club members. Regulations governing the use of the courts are the responsibility of the Recreation Committee and anyone who does not abide by these regulations is subject to the loss of tennis privileges. Membership and guest policies in effect at the pool for CHHA membership remain the same for membership use of the tennis courts.
2. No reservations are required for court use. Courts are used on a first come first serve basis. If others are present and waiting to also use the courts, we ask that you allow them to proceed at the end of your match.
3. Players are required to wear the proper tennis attire. Everyone must wear tennis shoes. No street shoes will be allowed on the courts.

Volleyball Court Use

1. The volleyball court and the playground is for the use of Concord Hills' residents. Any posted rules and regulations for their use must be observed.
2. CHHA members can reserve the use of the volleyball court for parties, but typically its use is first come first served.
3. People utilizing the court must ensure that all trash be placed in the proper receptacles when leaving.
4. The throwing of sand onto the tennis courts or abusing the nets is prohibited and may result in losing any privileges for its use, or for the use of membership privileges as appropriate.

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Guest Policy

1. Recreation Club members are entitled to invite guests to the pool, with a maximum allowance of 4 guests per family, per day. Those with family memberships may allow a child living within the home who is 12 years or older to bring a single guest without the supervision of a household adult. Guest must also be 12 years or older. A pool waiver must be signed by each visitor upon entry.
2. Special observer guests, such as visiting grandparents, who wish to watch their family, will be admitted without charge; babysitters, 12 years of age or older, may also fall into this category. Babysitters may swim and play tennis with the children. They may not return and use the facilities during non-babysitting hours.
3. Members are responsible for the actions of their guests, including restitution to the Association for any damages caused by their guests.
4. Attempts by any Recreation Club Member to provide non-member(s) with Member access privileges may result in the loss of membership privileges for the current season, or a part thereof.

Conduct

Good social conduct is everyone's responsibility. Running, pushing, wrestling, undue disturbance, or any other conduct which endangers the safety or enjoyment of other members, is prohibited. Foul or abusive language or behavior will not be tolerated.

Any offender will be given a warning. If the inappropriate behavior continues, the individual will be asked to leave the area and will not be allowed back for the remainder of the day. If a minor, his/her parent(s) will be called and informed of the infraction and the action taken. Repeat offenders or cases of gross misconduct will be referred to the Recreation Committee, before any of his/her privileges will be reinstated. If a minor, a parent will be required to attend that meeting prior to any reinstatement of membership privileges.

Private Parties

The CHHA Pavilion is available for private parties for a fee. Check with the Pool attendant or Board of Directors for the current season fee and requirements (party form available upon request)
